Removing Deceased Voters from Active Status

The most awkward conversation a poll worker can have on Election Day is a voter requesting to have a deceased loved one removed from the roster. Our office works diligently to prevent this situation.

The Shasta County Vital Records Office sends a monthly list of Death Certificates issued in Shasta County for individuals over 18 years old to our office. The election staff compares each name to our database and cancels these voters immediately. They will no longer receive any election mail or appear on any roster.

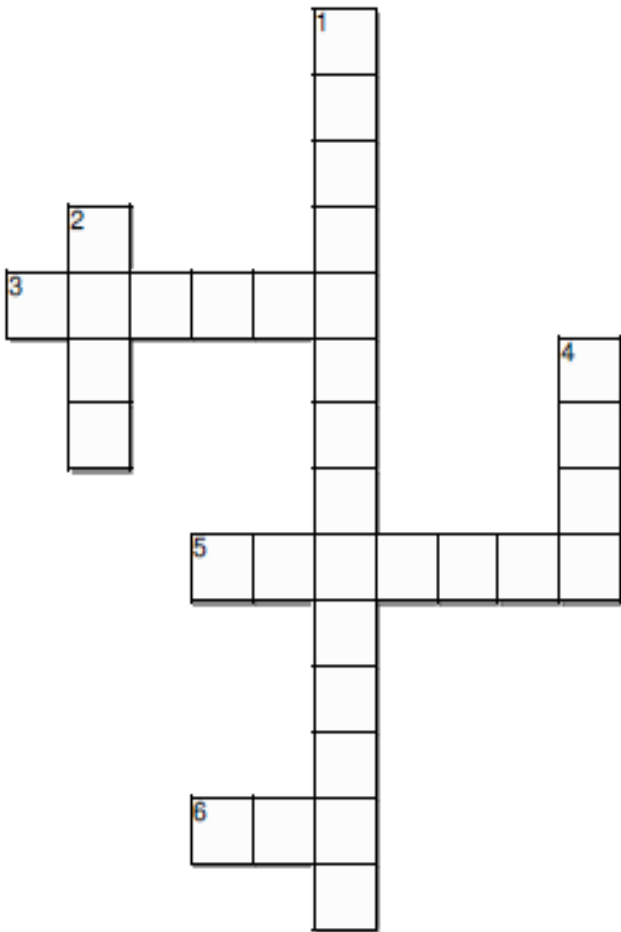
Additionally, our election staff logs into a program within our elections software which allows access to the Secretary of State's list of individuals who were issued death certificates in California. Those residing in Shasta County are reviewed and canceled. Keep in mind, if a voter passes away in another state, we will not be notified.

Removing Deceased voters from Active Status Cont.

We do receive calls from voters informing us that their loved one has passed and they request to have them removed from the system. Our office can only make these individuals inactive, which will stop election mail but their names will still appear on the roster. To have someone cancelled who died outside of California our office must receive a photo copy of the death certificate in person, by mail or fax.
