Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee (VAAC)

The Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee (VAAC) of Shasta and Tehama counties was established in 2014 and meets quarterly. The VAAC provides recommendations that help ensure voters with disabilities and seniors can vote independently and privately.

The American flag

The Flag of the United States of America is a symbol of freedom and liberty. The flag consists of 13 alternating red and white stripes that represent the 13 original colonies, and 50 white stars on a blue field, with each star representing a state. The colors on the flag represent:



- Red: valor and bravery
- White: purity and innocence
- Blue: vigilance, perseverance, and justice

Posting the flag at the polling place

The American flag must be displayed at the entrance of the polling place on Election Day. It assists, the voter in identifying the polling place and every inspector is given an American flag with their polling place supplies.
