New Provisional Hotline Proved Effective

The implementation of the provisional hotline significantly reduced the number of provisional ballots issued on Election Day.

As you know voters may not have their issued vote by mail ballot on Election Day. This can lead to a frustrating experience for both the voter and poll worker as they sort out the procedures. When you called our hotline, vote by mail voters were then able to vote a regular precinct ballot. This allowed the voters to have an overall better voting experience.

Not only was the hotline beneficial to the voter it also had a huge impact on our procedures after Election Day. You helped reduce the number of provisional ballots by 1700. It takes between 5-9 minutes to process 1 provisional ballot. This saved a minimum of 141 staff hours during canvass and allowed us to certify our election in a more efficient manner.

As with all we do, we know there is room for improvement on the hotline procedures and are hoping to hear any suggestions or feedback you may have. 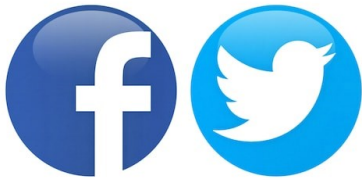

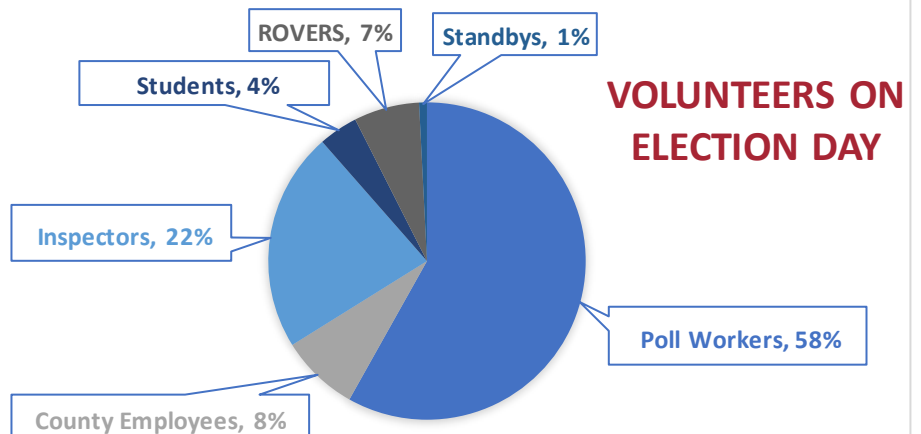
A Note from Cathy Darling Allen
