NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 a Primary Election will be held in Shasta County.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN THAT at the Primary Election to be held in Shasta County, the following ballot measure submitted to the voters will be entitled "Measure B."

"Shall the measure adding a special tax to replace, maintain and operate the Burney Fire Protection District facilities, vehicles, and equipment, to continue rapid response to Emergency Medical and fire calls be imposed and remain in effect without increase until ended by voters at a rate of \$29.00 per unimproved property, \$46.00 per one and two family residential property, \$104.00 per commercial property, and \$304.00 per industrial property, raising approximately \$103,372.00 annually, be adopted?"

Verified arguments for and against this measure are due to the County Clerk's office at 1643 Market Street in the Market Street Promenade. The County Clerk has determined December 6, 2019 to be a reasonable deadline to prepare and submit the arguments. Arguments are limited to 300 words. Arguments may be submitted by the governing board of the district or any member or members of the board, or an individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or a combination of these voters and associations may file a written argument for or against any district measure.

One argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distributing in the voter pamphlet. Preference and priority in selections will be given to arguments as follows:

1. The governing board of the Burney Fire Protection District or a member or members of the board.
2. The individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measure.
3. Bona fide associations of citizens.
4. Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that at the Primary Election of March 3, 2020, the polls will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that any direct argument, rebuttal argument or impartial analysis filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the County Clerk's office from December 14, 2019 to December 23, 2019.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN THAT at the Primary Election of March 3, 2020 there will be a central counting place for the tabulation of all ballots cast at said election. Said central counting place will be the Shasta County Elections Department at 1643 Market Street, Market Street Promenade, Redding, California.
