Qualifications for Irrigation Districts:

Must be a property owner with in the district and a resident of the division which he/she represents at the time of filing candidacy.

For all the offices listed above, Federal, State and local, any person who is a qualified registered voter, residing within the district boundaries, and qualified by the Constitution or laws of the State to hold a civil office is eligible.

Interested candidates for Redding City Council and Redding Treasurer file with Redding City Clerk.

Interested candidates for Shasta Lake City Council file with Shasta Lake City Clerk.

Interested candidates who reside in Shasta County can submit an application at www.elections.co.shasta.ca.us/candidate-application/, or contact Shasta County Elections at Elections@co.shasta.ca.us or 530-225-5730 to request an application. All candidate filing requirements must be completed before 5:00 PM Friday August 7, 2020. Further information is

contained in the General Election November 2020 Candidate Guide, available at www.elections.co.shasta.ca.us.

If by August 7th, 2020, an incumbent does not file a declaration of candidacy, any person, other than the incumbent, has until 5 pm on Wednesday, August 12th, 2020, to file. This extension does not apply when there is no incumbent.

If by August 12th, 2020, no one has filed for an office, the supervising authority appoints a qualified person on or before Election Day. The appointed person qualifies and takes office as if elected.
