@ UOCAVA Remote Accessible Vote by Mail (RAVBM) Instructions

Remote Accessible Vote by Mail (RAVBM) allows you to mark your ballot electronically, print and return it by fax or mail back to the Elections Office.

How to access your ballot

You will receive a link and Voter Access Code in an email from info@uocava.com. This code is specific to your voter record.

1. Follow the link and select "Begin Ballot Marking."
2. On the "Voter Declaration & Login" page enter the following:
 - a. Voter Access Code
 - b. birth year.

Mark your ballot

Follow the instructions on the screen to select your choice for each contest. When you finish marking your selections, the system will give you the opportunity to review your selections.

Print your ballot

After reviewing your selections, select Mark and Print Ballot to download your marked ballot and Voter Oath and Declaration. You must print and return these files.

Sign your Oath

Read and sign the Voter Oath and Declaration.

How to return your voted ballot by fax or mail.

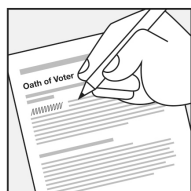
Under California State Law, you cannot return your ballot by email. You must return your ballot via fax or mail.

Returning your ballot by fax

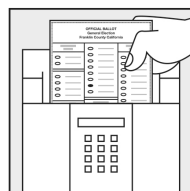
- Read and sign the Oath and Declaration of Voter.
- Fax the signed Oath and Declaration, and marked ballot, to 530-225-5454 by 8pm Pacific Standard Time on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

Sign & date oath



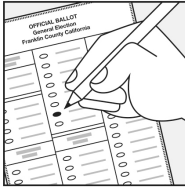
Fax oath & voted ballot

Returning your ballot by mail

- Read and sign the Oath and Declaration.
- Place your marked ballot, Voter Oath & Declaration in an envelope.
- Postage must be paid when mailed from a non-US post office.
- A Postage Paid envelope label can be printed from the website below:

- Attach label to envelope and mail to:
Shasta County Elections
PO Box 990880
Redding, CA 96099-0880
- Mail your ballot so that it is postmarked on or before Election Day and received by our office no later than 17 days after Election Day.
- You must pay postage when mailed from a non-US post office.
