

Notice of Intention to Circulate Recall Petition

To the honorable Virginia Bassham: Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned registered voters of Clear Creek Community Service District, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we seek your recall and removal from the office of Board of Directors, in Shasta County, California, and demand election of a successor in that.

The grounds for the proposed recall are as follows:

- 1) Failed in your fiduciary responsibilities.
- 2) Depleted reserve accounts.
- 3) No standing committee meetings in over 2 years.
- 4) Prop 218 and Brown Act violations

Election Code section 11023. (a) Within seven days after filing of the notice of intention, the officer sought to be recalled may file with the elections official, or in case of a state officer, the Secretary of State, an answer, in not more than 200 words, to the statement of the proponents. (b) If an answer is filed, the officer shall, within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, also serve a copy of it, by personal delivery or by certified mail, on one of the proponents named in the notice of intention. (c) The answer shall be signed and shall be accompanied by the printed name and business or residence address of the officer to be recalled.
